In Maths this term we will learning and exploring number and place value, addition and subtraction.

In RE we will be looking at a friendship and what it means to be a good friend and in our Art we will be learning about texture and tone through using pencils and different media. 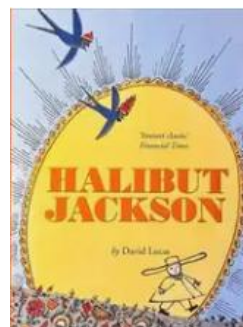
